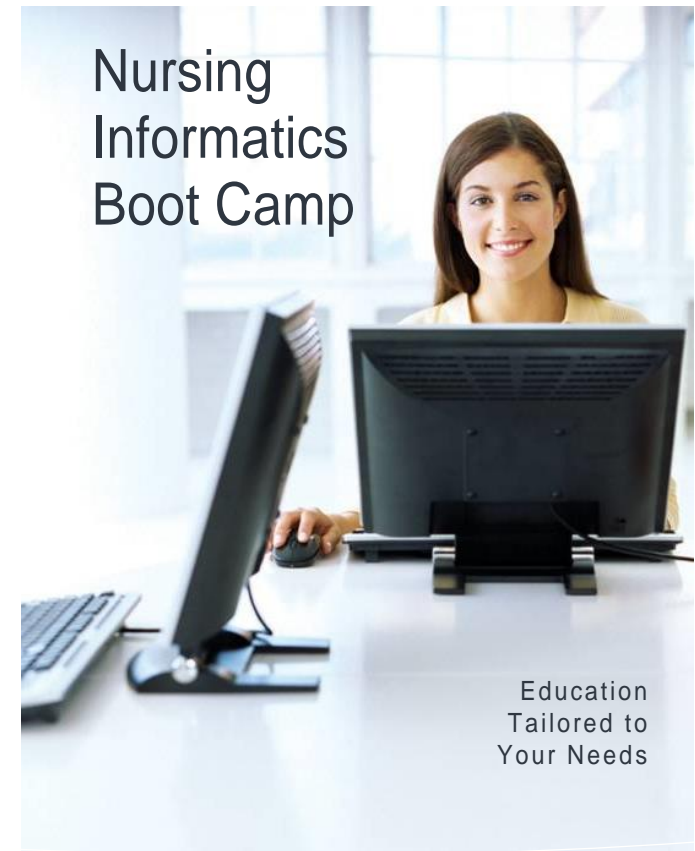

This course goes beyond the ANCC outline to discuss current trends and issues.

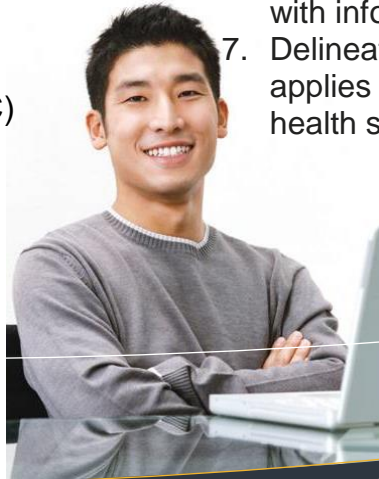
Taught by informatics professionals with recent healthcare informatics experience.
