Cyber Attacks & HIPAA Compliance: Prepared?

Examine the risk to vital assets including EPHI and PII from attacks such as APT, DoS, DDoS and many others. Understand how to effectively address HIPAA & HITECH mandates and ensure a resilient information infrastructure.

The brief describes step by step how attacks are launched on your networks without detection or discovery. Examine the critical areas that must be secured appropriately to ensure personally identifiable information is not compromised. Understand several threat scenarios, including, the hacker is in your attic, malware plantation, and techniques used to gain control of your critical servers to access passwords.

More than ever before, these cyber-attacks require that covered entities and business associates must perform a formal risk assessment exercise periodically to identify gaps that can be exploited. However, what constitutes a thorough and comprehensive risk assessment exercise? What are the core components of such an exercise? How does one develop a functional treatment plan based on information in the risk assessment report? In this brief, we step through key areas that must be addressed within the scope of a risk assessment exercise. Several standards and guidance documents exist that provide insight; these are examined to identify not just the "what" aspect of risk assessment but also "how" to determine the weak links that need to be clearly discovered within the scope of the exercise.
